HIGHWAY – AUTHORIZE LOCAL FUNDS FOR PECK HOLLOW BRIDGE

Authorizing the implementation, and funding in the first instance 100% of the Federal-aid and State-aid eligible costs, of a transportation federal-aid and/or state-aid transportation project, and appropriating funds therefore.

Whereas, a Project for the Bridge Replacement of Peck Hollow Road over Peck Hollow Stream in the Town of Shandaken, Ulster County (BIN 2270000) identified as PIN 8761.61 (the "Project") is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs such program to be borne at the ratio of 95% Federal funds and 5% non-federal funds; and

Whereas, the Town of Shandaken will design, let and construct the Project; and

Whereas, the Town of Shandaken desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the non-federal share of the costs of preliminary engineering and right-of-way incidental work.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, the Shandaken Town Board hereby approves the above-subject project; and it is hereby further

Be It Further Resolved, that the Shandaken Town Board hereby authorizes the Town of Shandaken to pay in the first instance 100% of the federal and non-federal share of the cost of preliminary engineering and right-of-way incidental work for the Project or portions thereof;

And Further Resolved, that the Shandaken Town Board hereby agrees that the Town of Shandaken shall be responsible for all cost of the project which exceed the amount of the NY Bridge Funding awarded to the Town of Shandaken.

And Further Resolved, that the sum of \$160,000 is hereby appropriated from *Highway Fund Line - P.I. Signs/Guiderails (DA 55112400)* and made available to cover the cost of participation in the above phase of the Project;

And Further Resolved, that in the event the full federal and non-federal share costs of the project exceeds the amount appropriated above, the Shandaken Town Board shall convene as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the Town Supervisor thereof,

And Further Resolved, that the Town of Shandaken hereby agrees that construction of the Project shall begin no later than eighteen (18) months after award and that the project shall be completed within three years of commencing construction;

And Further Resolved, that the Supervisor of the Town of Shandaken be and is hereby authorized to execute all necessary Agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal Aid and/or State-Aid on behalf of the Town of Shandaken with the New York State Department of Transportation in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's first instance funding of project costs and permanent funding of the local share of federal-aid and state-aid eligible Project costs and all Project costs within appropriations therefore that are not so eligible,

And Further Resolved, that in addition to the Town Supervisor the following municipal titles: Highway Superintendent, Town Engineer, and Deputy Town Supervisor are also hereby authorized to execute any necessary Agreements or certifications on behalf of the Municipality/Sponsor, with NYSDOT in connection with the advancement or approval of the project identified in the State/Local Agreement,

And Further Resolved, that a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary Agreement in connection with the Project, and

And Further Resolved, this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
